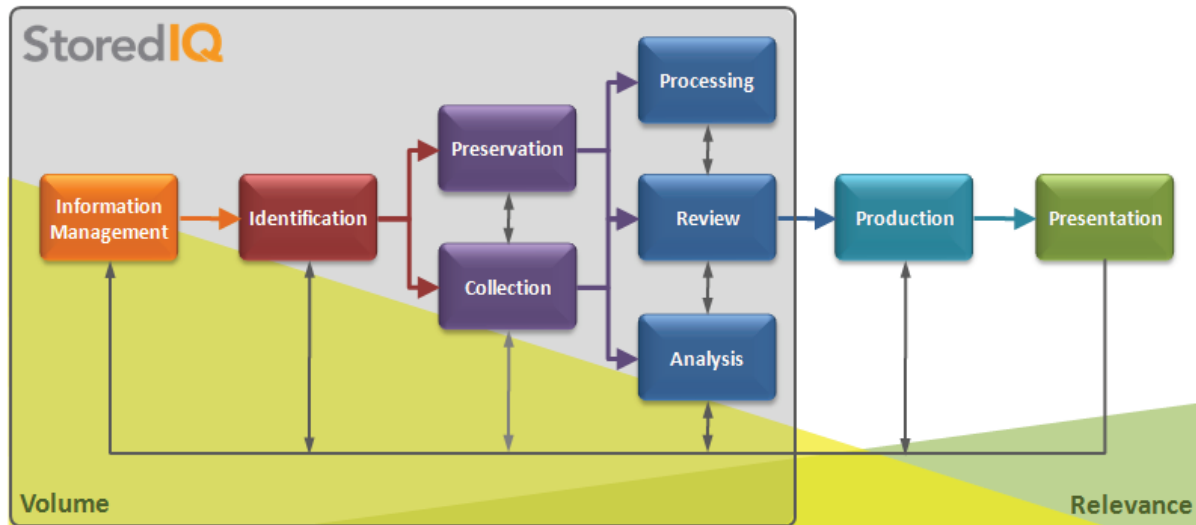

Information Management

Identification

StoredIQ finds, indexes, and searches for ESI on the industry's broadest set of data sources, including storage, email, archiving, content, document and record management systems, as well as group shares, files shares, and personal workstations. StoredIQ also creates customizable data topology maps of all ESI, based on hundreds of indexed and retained metadata attributes.

Collection

StoredIQ crawls and collects data on the entire network ecosystem of servers, storage systems and personal computers—without disrupting employees, and can move or copy it to a retention platform. No gateways or agent software have to be installed or maintained, and the solution is entirely transparent to end users.

Preservation

StoredIQ secures collected data on retention platforms and authenticates the entire process by maintaining audit logs and comparing hash values before and after collection. In addition, access control lists (ACLs) and security identifiers (SIDs) are preserved, proving file ownership as tracked by the file system.

Analysis

Leveraging StoredIQ's proprietary Analyze Anywhere™ technology, inside counsel can conduct true early case assessment of live ESI even prior to collection, enabling organizations to develop matter strategies sooner, while reducing the overall costs of litigation. StoredIQ's legal-friendly workflow simplifies the entire eDiscovery process of data analysis and first pass review.

Processing

StoredIQ culls ESI to the minimum, legally defensible subset of potentially responsive data, further reducing costs of downstream formal legal review. The solution can de-duplicate globally or within custodians, review system output and perform rolling productions of industry-standard load files. Throughout the entire eDiscovery process, StoredIQ will create and maintain audit trails and chains of custody to ensure court-proven defensibility.
